

A regular meeting of the Bracken County Fiscal Court was held Wednesday, December 22, 2010, for the purpose of transacting any business properly presented by the established agenda.

Presiding: Scotty Lippert,
Magistrate

*Let the record reflect that Judge Riggs was absent and Scotty Lippert presided over the meeting.

Present: Carl Allen, Clark Hennessey, David Kelsch, Tim Figgins, Scotty Lippert, Jr., John Corlis, Neil Brumley, and Dennis Jefferson.

Let the Record reflect that the Court members received a copy of the vendor claims to be paid for all funds.

Upon Motion of David Kelsch seconded by John Corlis the minutes of the Meeting December 8, 2010 be accepted/approved.

Vote being unanimous.

Constables

Discussion was held among Magistrates and County Attorney, Mike Clark.

Motion was made by John Corlis to approve Resolution (copy attached) which would have set the bond for each constable at \$10,000, to be paid by the constables and to permit any constable that completed training through the Department of Justice to be permitted to install and run blue lights and sirens on his Constable vehicle and to permit such Constable use of the county owned radio frequencies used by law enforcement.

Motion died for a lack of a second.

Motion was made by David Kelsch to approve Resolution 10-10 which would set the bond for each Constable at \$10,000, to be paid by the Constable and that no Constable shall be permitted to run blue lights, use sirens, or be permitted on the radio frequencies owned by the County. In addition, an costs of training shall be paid by the Constable should he/she wish to obtain training, seconded by John Corlis.

Vote being unanimous.

County Surveyor

Discussion was had by the magistrates and the County Attorney. The County Attorney stated that the salary for Harold Woodward over the past twelve years had been paid under the budgeting item labeled "County Surveyor". Actually, this salary had been given to Harold Woodward as the "Keeper of the 911 database" and as "The Flood Plain Coordinator". There was no salary established for the County Surveyor. However, it could be argued that the positions of "keeper of the 911 database: and "Flood Plain Coordinator" were duties added to the duties of the County Surveyor. The court needs to decide whether they want to declare there is no salary for County Surveyor and that the position of "keeper of the 911 database" and "Flood Plain Coordinator" will be filled by a person or persons hired. Or court can decide to give Greg Taylor the positions of "keeper of the 911 database" and "Flood Plain Coordinator" and require him to be trained for both positions. In this later case the court would declare that there is no salary for County surveyor, however, Greg Taylor as County Surveyor will be hired to fill the two positions and be trained in order to draw the salary for each. Should Greg Taylor fail to be trained for both positions the court will declare the two positions vacant and hire someone to fill them. Greg Taylor submitted a letter which stated that he would be trained to handle the 911 database position and that he would be trained to handle the duties as Flood Plain Coordinator.

Motion was made by Dennis Jefferson to approve the attached Resolution 10-11, seconded by John Corlis.

Vote being unanimous.
