Judge Executive Bush called the meeting to order and informed those in attendance that the floor was open to any public comment regarding Ordinance 14-01; regarding development of Regional Sewer Authority

*Larry Bradley addressed the court regarding his concerns regarding:

- *Cost for each person joining the sewer line, should it be established before this ordinance?
- *Concerns regarding site approval, existing lines, and exact routes of sewer lines.
- *Concerns that it is early for development of a Regional Sewer Authority

*Judge Bush advised that the Regional Authority needs to be developed and in place for engineers to design plans for this project. Designs would include site of plant, exact routes of new lines, and estimated costs for each person connected to the line.

Therefore, it is assumed the Bracken County Fiscal Court move forward with the Second Reading and Adoption of this ordinance.
